NAMS CARGO SURVEYORS TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. All applicants must answer **all** questions in Section One. Questions are True/False and each correct answer is worth one point.
- 2. All applicants must answer as many questions as possible in Section Two. Answers are multiple choice and correct answers are worth two points each. Pick the most applicable answer from the selections provided.
- 3. All applicants must pick **one** of the three sections that comprise Section Three and answer as many questions as possible in the selected section. The choices are:
 - a. Section Three A: General Cargo Surveyor
 - b. Section Three B: Draft Surveyor
 - c. Section Three C: Liquid Cargo and Tanker Surveyor

Correct answers for Section Three $-\mathbf{A}$ are worth ten points each and all questions should be answered. Correct answers for Sections Three $-\mathbf{B}$ and \mathbf{C} are worth four points each and all questions should be answered.

- 4. Applicants are allowed to bring in three reference books as follows:
 - a. International Maritime Organization (IMO), "Code of Safe Working Practice for Cargo Stowage and Securing"
 - b. IMSBC Code 2012 Edition
 - c. National Cargo Bureau, Inc. (NCB), "General Information for Grain Loading"

Applicants may refer only to these three books during the course of the examination.

5. Upon completion, the test sheets shall be placed in a sealed envelope and handed to the Proctor for return to the NAMS office for review.
